



## CURRICULUM AND PASTORAL COMMITTEE

### Remit

**Membership:** No fewer than 3 Governors plus the Head Teacher

The Committee shall have such co-opted members as the Governing Body shall appoint. The Committee may make recommendations to the Governing Body for these appointments.

**Quorum:** 3 Governors plus the Head Teacher

#### General

Decisions made by the committee must be consistent with the implementation of the National Curriculum. The remit of the committee is the provision of Religious Education and Collective Worship, Curriculum Policies, the Governing Body's Sex Education Policy, Learners' care and well being, Equality and Diversity, Target setting, equal opportunities, the provision for pupils with special educational needs and the priorities identified within the School Development Plan.

#### Specific Terms of Reference:

To monitor and review consider and review the school policy and required criteria ensuring all areas of the National Curriculum are covered.

To approve Curriculum and Pastoral policy documents except where delegation is not permitted.

To monitor pupil attendance and punctuality.

To agree and monitor the Performance Management Policy

To review School Performance through available data.

To review the school systems for assessment and tracking of pupil performance.

To monitor the School Development Plan.

To consider and ensure that the requirements of children with Special Educational Needs and 'Disadvantaged' pupils are met.

To maintain an overview of all school related policies and ensure their regular review.

The Committee shall meet once each half term or otherwise as required.
